#### **Motorcycle Rider Course Options**

Hello Texas Riders! One of the best activities you can do for yourself in 2019 is to take a riding course to hone and reinforce your skills on the street. GWRRA offers 10 different courses to help you achieve this. I know some of you might be thinking, "Yeah, but I can't ever find a class being offered close to me!" I know a lot of you take the courses to keep your Levels current (and I strongly support that) but did you know there are a lot more classes out there that can also be counted for the Levels program?

Following is the list of "Approved" Rider Courses for use in the GWRRA Levels Program. The first group of courses have a classroom and range component and should be taken every 3 years to maintain Levels.

TC-ARC Total Control Advanced Rider Clinic (Lee Parks)

TC-INT Total Control Intermediate Rider Clinic

TRC Trike Rider Course (GWRRA)

TTRC Trike w/ Trailer Rider Course (GWRRA)

VRC Vanguard Rider Course (GWRRA)


Co-Riders may of course also take the "Co-Rider" Seminar to maintain their levels.
