

Dear EWMA Teammates and Riding Friends:

Preventative maintenance is of primary importance in maintaining any mechanical piece of equipment, thus assuring performance, when needed. Our motorcycles (no matter the manufacturer) require regular maintenance (T-CLOCK before each ride) and manufacturer's suggested maintenance based on the interval of riding time or chronological time. These maintenance schedules are suggested, but not demanded. Thus we, as riders, have a choice to perform the designated maintenance, on the prescribed intervals or perform the fix, once the bike breaks down.

One of the major challenges in the larger bikes (Goldwing's, Ultra Classics, Etc.) have electrical systems that can be very complex and extremely expensive to repair. Tracing down an electrical challenge can be time consuming and time adds dollars to the cost of the repair.

Many riders have the knowledge and tools to trace the electrical issues and correct the correctable. Me...I do not have the knowledge, skills, tools, and patience to trace electrical challenges. Additionally, I did not install any of the electronics on my Goldwing (2005 GL1800), but had all electronics installed at various rally's, by whomever the manufacturer's technician was at the time of install. Consequently, the work varied...greatly, regarding the workmanship.

I was having some major electrical challenges that resulted in sections of the bike's electrical system not functioning. I.E. the fog lights did not work; the PIA lights did not work, running lights would not work; horn would not work...the list continues on and on and on... Additionally, I had my rear deferential go out, loosing the drive shaft and both U-Joints, this is after a shop in Arkansas, who installs the trike conversion kit on my GL1800, replaced the bearings in the rear end.

Understand preventative and regular maintenance is something that was always performed on my GL1800 (2005 Honda Goldwing), ever since I purchased the bike, new, in 2005.

I researched the rear end and found All Makes Cycle Repair/Service, at 1503 MLK Jr. Blvd, in Killeen (phone 254-680-6881) who was able to secure the parts and repair the bike. (Note: They are a dealer for Motor Trike). After a brief test ride, it was now time to correct the electrical challenges.

There is an individual in Granbury, Texas, who came highly recommended by the former Texas District Educator (Leo Smith) and has many followers from multiple Dallas area motorcycle riders. This individual has his own shop in the back of his house; has a set-up that would eclipse any motorcycle's service department, and charges much less (about ¼ the hourly rate of many dealerships) for quality that is superior to any shop I have encountered.

His motorcycle knowledge of the electrical operation is unparalleled, coupled with his available resources, complemented by his very reasonable hourly rate.

I meticulously reviewed all electrical challenges on the bike, call Paul Lustenhouwer with the issues, for direction on what might need to be ordered, documented the challenges, reviewed the potential parts required, and trailered the bike to 1737 Temple Hall Highway, Granbury, Texas 76049, to share the list of 15 line-item repairs with Paul Lustenhouwer. (Note: Paul's cell number is 817-980-8184.)

Paul confirmed what was needed; the parts were ordered from various manufacturers suggested by Paul; the repair parts were sent directly to Paul's shop in Granbury, Texas, and two weeks later I had a bike that is electrically sound, mechanically sound, and ready for the next Big Bend trip.

Paul worked on the bike for 23-hours, over a total of 6-days. The charge was very reasonable and well worth the 21/2-hour trip to Granbury, Texas.
